

1. Student's Council: The Student's Council is formed in every academic year as per the guidelines laid down by Savitribai Phule Pune University Pune and Maharashtra Public University Act 2016. In the Academic year 2021-2022, even though university withheld the student's council elections, student's council was formed at the college level. The nominated class representatives elect one of them as their university representative (UR). The UR represents students of the affiliated college at the university level. The college has Students Council that consists of Principal as the chairman and other as Members.

2. Students Consumer Co-operative Store: This is a support service provided to students on the campus. The store has books, educational and other essential goods and services. The store administration is looked after by a committee that has student's representative, Principal as the chairman, the Coordinator, the Secretary Members, Nominated five Students and Two Non-teaching staff members.

3. Internal Quality Assurance Cell: The IQAC is a crucial quality enhancement body of the college. The committee consists of Principal as the chairman, Members: One College Management representative, Coordinator, Four Teachers, Two Alumni Representatives, One Industrialist, One External Expert, One Office Representative, Two Community Representatives and Two Student Representatives.

4. NSS and NCC: The NSS and NCC representatives help for maintaining disciplines on the campus, plantation and Beautification of campus.



**Board of Students' Development
Report 2021-22**

The Board of Students Development is an important committee at the college, and under this committee that the Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil Earn and Learn Scheme is implemented for students. Apart from this, various lectures and training programs are conducted under the Nirbhay Kanya Abhiyan for girl students and disaster management workshops for all students. Various days are observed during the academic year such as tree plantation; various days include Goodwill Day, Reading Inspiration Day, Voter's Day, Constitution Day, etc.

Also, programs are organized on different topics. Prize ceremonies are organized for meritorious students in the annual art festival. Due to the aftermath of Covid-19, all colleges and teaching positions were closed as of March 2020. The University Grants Commission, the Center, and the State Government have given instructions to do it in a regular manner. In order to bring the educational work back to normal, this "Mission Yuva Swasthya" campaign was implemented by the government of Maharashtra for the students as well as the teachers and staff in the college premises as per the instructions of the Director, Directorate of Higher Education, Pune Division. Under this, a vaccination campaign was implemented between October 25 and November 2, 2021.

Mission Yuva Swasthya- Vaccination Program

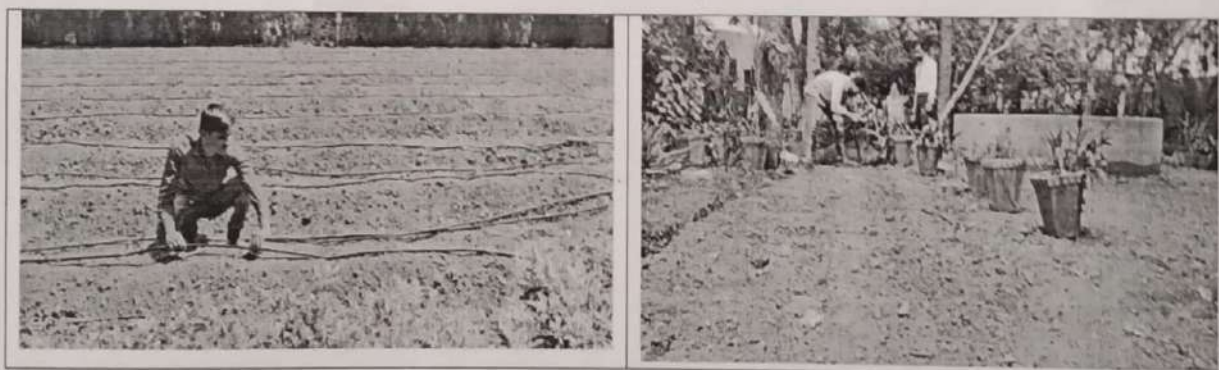
Under the "Mission Yuva Swasthya" campaign, a vaccination campaign was organised at Chandamal Tarachand Bora College on October 29th in collaboration with Rural Hospital Shirur. According to a survey conducted by the Student Development Board through Google Forms, approximately 80 percent of the students have received their first dose of immunisation at the individual level. Although 400 students were registered for this vaccination, only 75 took advantage of it because they were under the age of eighteen. This vaccination campaign was inaugurated by the principal of the college, Dr. K.C. Mohite. Dr. Shinde of the rural hospital expressed his concern and talked about raising awareness about vaccination. Student Development Officer Dr. Suraj Sawant coordinated the program, and Dr. Ket proposed the vote of thanks. On this occasion, morning session-in-charge Prof. Jadhav, Shri. Mahamuni of the Rural Hospital, an NSS officer, an NCC officer, and other

professors were present. Mr. Anil Bora, President of Shirur Shikshan Prasarak Mandal, and Secretary Mr. Nandkumar Nikam paid a visit and expressed their support for the vaccination campaign.



Earn and Learn Scheme

After the colleges were started as per the instructions of the university, under the Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil Earn and Learn Scheme, work was made available to the needy students. Under this scheme, twenty needy students were included in this program for four months, from February to May.



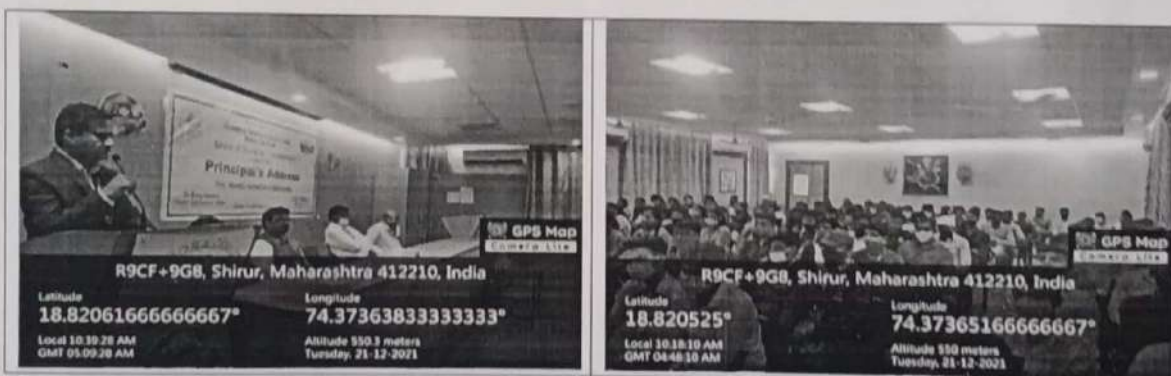
Constitution Day

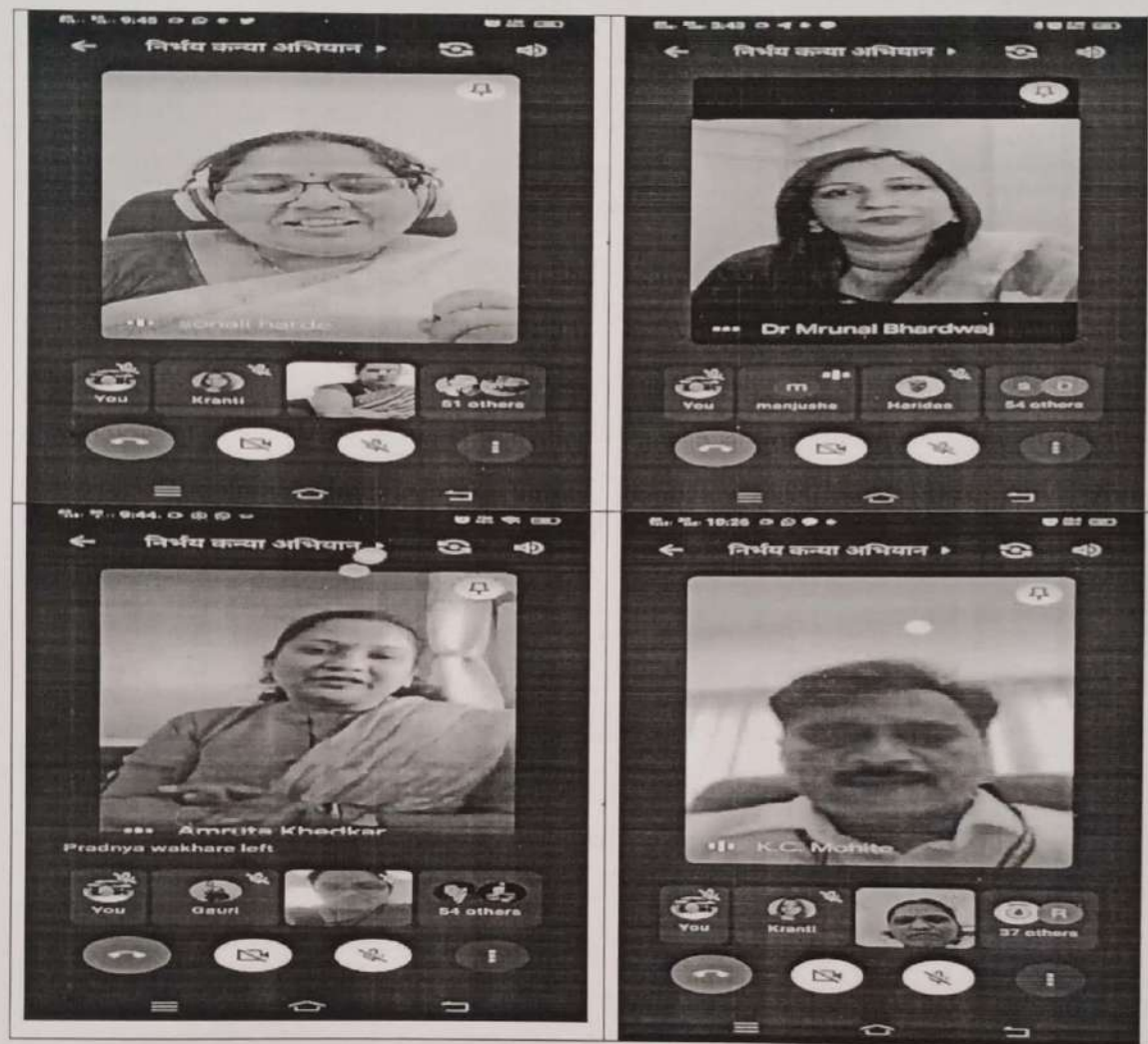

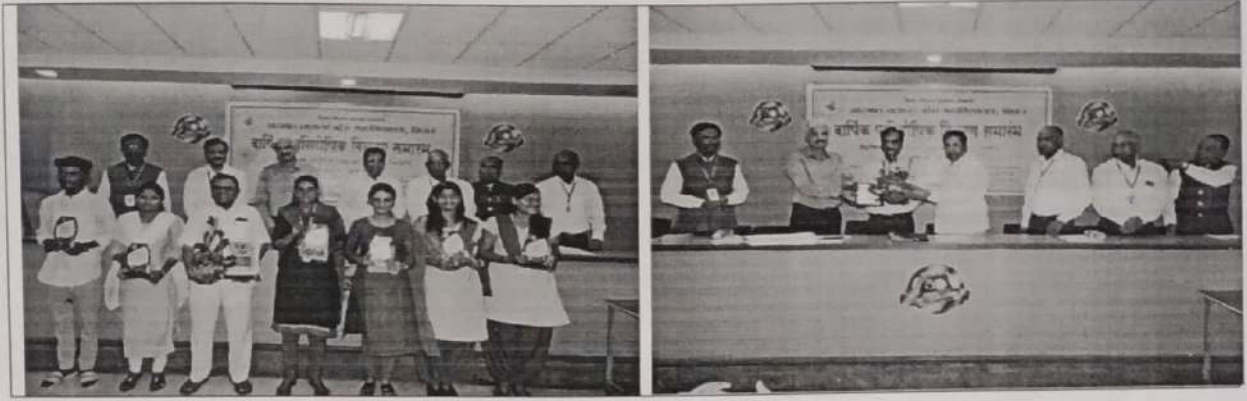


Also, poster presentations and a Rangoli competition were organised for the students of the college, and the lectures got a spontaneous response from the students.

Our college NCC unit is E Company 15 Platoon (Infantry) senior division with strength of 50 cadets registered under the 36 Maharashtra Boys Battalion Pune Group Head Quarter. We have started regular activity for Second year and Third Year cadets on 26th July 2021 and regular parade was started from Tuesday 27th September 2021. Institutional Training being conducted in the College was the principle training programme of the NCC unit. The aim of the training is to nurture core values, enhance awareness and to give exposure to basic military skills and knowledge. Most importance is given to practical training.
