Competitive Exam Center is one of leading center of Chandamal Tarachand Bora College which is constantly contributing and monitoring in various ways to the students, teachers in our surrounding area. A part of it, virtual online mode educational interaction with headmasters and teachers of Shirur ,Shrigonda and Parner,and Haveli. Under the guidance and prior permission of the Honourable Principal, Dr. Kakasaheb Mohite, the online educational conversation activity organised by the Competitive exam Committee. Mr. Tukaram Benke, President of Shirur Taluka Secondary and Higher Secondary school, and Mr. Ramdas Thite, Secretary, Shirur Taluka Secondary and Higher Secondary Union Shirur, have min involvement of college in surrounding school education programme.

Competitive Exam Center Chandamal Tarachand Bora College every year takes the Rasiklalji M. Dhariwal Memorial General Knowledge exam. During the academic year this exam was conducted on 12 January 2021.First examination was conducted in 1997 . 130 students were present for the said exam.This year marks the 25th year of this competitive exam. This exam is conducted in two groups (5th to 7th small group and 8th to 9th big group).

Due to Corona, this exam was conducted online this year. Approximately Three thousand students appeared for this exam this year.
