Annual Report 2021-22

In the reporting academic year 2021-22, examination committee meetings were held from time to time as per the necessity. In each meeting various important subjects related to the planning and execution of assessment and evaluation as per the changed pattern such as credit course, internal examination, university online and offline examination were discussed and the necessary decisions were taken.

Special Meeting on Credit System- On 7th December 2021 Meetings of Morning Session at 11.15 am and afternoon session at 3.00 pm were held to discuss credit system and its implementation under the guidance of Hon. Principal, Dr. K. C. Mohite. Savitribai Phule Pune University has started credit system from 2019. The review was taken related to the earned credits in last two years and the required credits in the final year of the degree for the students of all classes. The dimensions of credits earning process including compulsory credits and the optional credits and the semester wise required credits have been discussed. The examination department gave information to the teachers about the credits earning proceed in details. It was decided that especially every third-year student is necessary to be made aware about credits earning process. All the professors were made aware about the various options available through which students can earn the additional credits.

In the meeting it is discussed in details that in each degree course student has to ear minimum 132 compulsory credits along with the 08 additional credits i.e. total 140 credits. In detail information was given about the credits of physical education, democracy and governance, environmental awareness. Hon. Principal Dr. K. C. Mohite guided the professors and explained the details of credit system. Morning Session In charge Prof. H. S. Jadhav and afternoon session In charge Prof. R. P. Ganorkar expressed their opinion about the credit system. The faculty actively participated in the discussion to sketch out the institutional road map for the successful implementation of the credit system. In the meeting, it was decided that every professor should give information about the credit system at their respective level. All the teachers are appealed to help the students to fill examination forms.

Information to the students about the examination- All the students admitted in the first-year were made to understand the process of filling the correct examination forms. All the students from Arts, Commerce, Science, B.B.A., B.C.A. were guided by going class to class. In the first semester, students are required to create an account on the university site. The detail information was given to the students. It is informed to the students that they have to use their own e-mail ID and mobile number while creating an

account. On the same mobile number and mail ID the university communicates the students regarding exam results and other details throughout the degree duration. The examination team created accounts of the students those who were present in the class. Students are informed to get their subjects and subject names from their teacher and fill the examination form properly. Students are also given information on how to get the needed credits. It is also informed that students have to fill the examination form as per the schedule declared by the university.

Filling of Examination Form- As per the 2019 C.B.C.S. pattern students are required to earn eight additional credits. The information regarding this was given to the students through all the professors and department heads. The examination forms of all the students were filled by the respective departments in the presence of the students. Additional credit related various requirements were completed by the concerned departments. The students are also made aware of the requirements of additional credits that they need.

Keeping in mind that the post-corona examinations will be conducted as they were earlier i.e. in the traditional manner, the college conducted internal examinations for all students in the month of May by deciding the combine format of multiple-choice and descriptive.

All the examinations were conducted smoothly under the guidance of the Hon. Principal, and with the cooperation of all examination committee members as well as professors.
